DR. LANCE E. KISBY



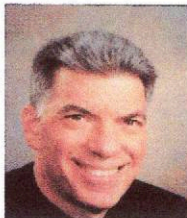
- Chief of Pediatric Dentistry – Geisinger Medical Center, Danville, Pa.
