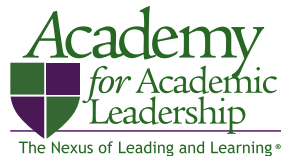

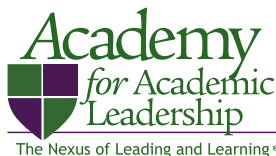

Blended-Learning Format

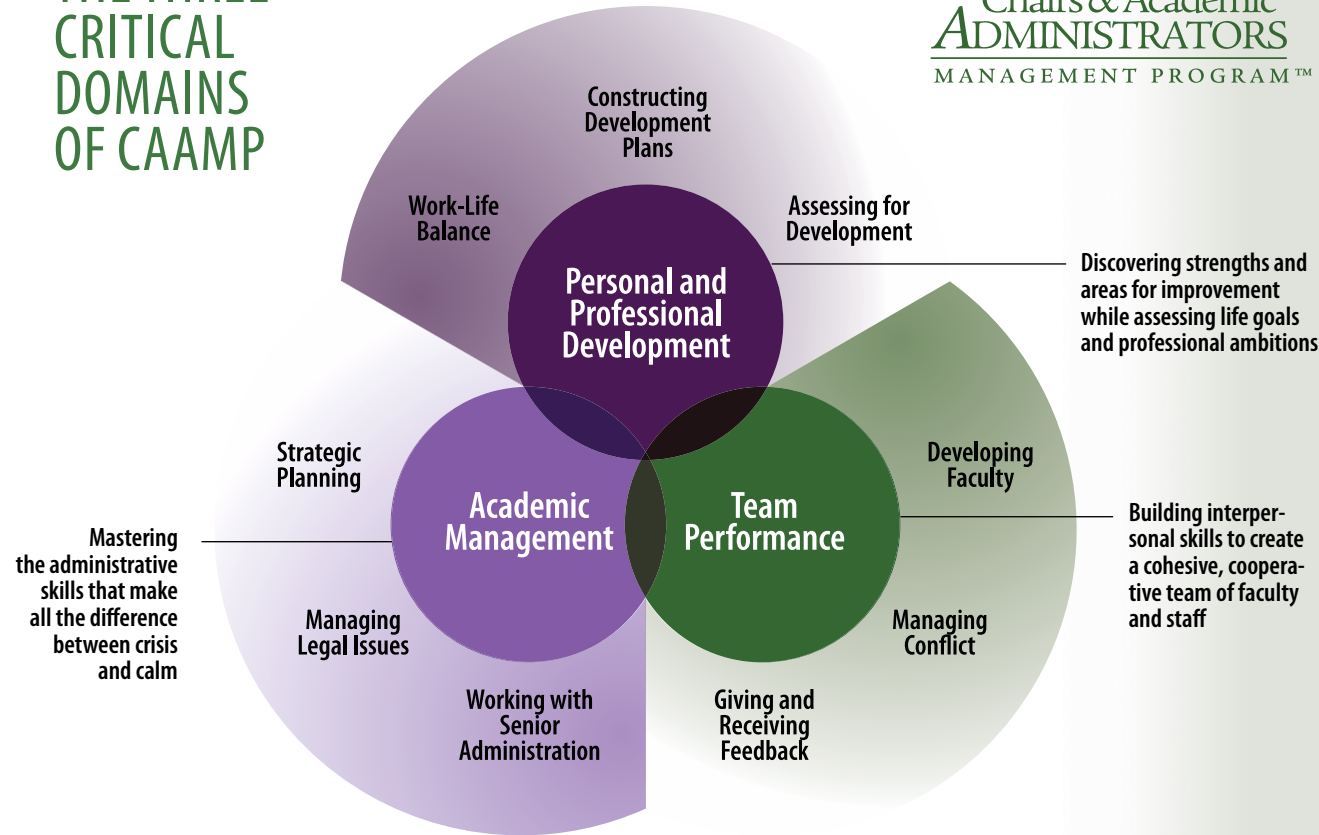
CAAMP provides participants with three modes of learning:
